**An Integrated Approach to HCV Treatment Among those with
Mental Illness and Substance Use Disorders**

Course Description:

This is an introductory course intended for multidisciplinary professionals who work with individuals diagnosed Hepatitis C Virus (HCV). The Center for Disease Control indicates that the number of people infected with HCV is on the rise. The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) identifies that people experiencing behavioral health issues and substance use issues are at higher risk for HCV. The course will describe the basics of HCV, treatment modalities, and potential barriers to treatment compliance. There will be a focus on working with individuals diagnosed with co-occurring disorders in an integrated care setting. A strong emphasis will be placed on honoring the dignity and worth of the person diagnosed with HCV and co-occurring disorders, through evidence-based practices.

Course Facilitator:

Taylor Pettit, LMSW, CAADC, is a Trainer within the Workforce Development department. She has been with Cherry Health since 2013 and previously did clinical work as a therapist and case manager within integrated health settings.

Course Objectives:

1. Distinguish the difference between acute and chronic HCV
2. Describe the correlation between HCV, Substance Use Disorders, and Mental Illnesses
3. Demonstrate knowledge of Evidence Based Treatment modalities for addressing Substance Use Disorders and Mental Illness needs, among those diagnosed with HCV
4. Explain the benefits of integrated care services for those undergoing HCV treatment
