Course Description:

With cannabis use on the rise, the political and scientific debates surrounding the benefits and consequences of cannabis use seem to be at an all-time high in the United States. This perplexing climate has left many people wondering: What does this mean for the public? If it's legal, does it mean it's safe? Are Marijuana and CBD the same thing? This course will take a closer look at the complexity of the cannabis plant, MI laws, short-term and long-term implications of use, varying methods of use, and clinical implications for behavioral health professionals.
